FEIS SYLLABUS

VENUE: St. Joachims. 22-24 Crown St. Holland Park

DATE: Sunday 16th May 2010

ADMISSION FEE: **There will not be an admission/venue levy fee.**
This usual fee has been incorporated into the increased entry fee per dance.

ENTRY FEES: \$11.00 per dance
\$15.00 per Trophy Dance.
\$88.00 Family limit
\$16.00 per Team

Entries will be taken on the day of the Feis. See below for conditions.

Please note the following conditions of entry

1. To be eligible to compete in this Feis, all competitors must be registered with AIDA (QLD) or the AIDA branch in their region.
2. Aida Qld registration numbers will be used for this Feis. Dancers **MUST** bring their number to the Registration desk when they register to compete.
Dancers not Registered in Brisbane will be given a competitor number.
3. Dancers are only permitted to enter dances in which they are officially graded. All dancers **MUST** have recently checked their gradings with their teacher.
4. There is no limit to the number of dances a dancer can enter, as long as they are entering in the correct grade.
5. Dancers age groups will be taken by the age they were on 1st January.
6. Trophy dance. Trophies will be awarded to the Top 5 dancers in each trophy section.
7. There is no restriction to TEAM dancer's grades. Dancers graded Intermediate and Open will be permitted to dance in these sections.

Dances

1. NOVICE REEL - For first time competitors. This will be offered in all age groups.
2. BEGINNERS -
REEL (Trophy Dance), LIGHT JIG, SINGLE JIG, SLIP JIG, HEAVY JIG, HORNSPIPE
3. PRIMARY -
REEL, LIGHT JIG, SINGLE JIG, SLIP JIG, HEAVY JIG, TRADITIONAL SET DANCE (Trophy Dance)
4. INTERMEDIATE -
REEL (Trophy Dance) SLIP JIG, HEAVY JIG, TRADITIONAL SET DANCE
5. 4 HAND CEILI. Under 11 years. Under 13 years.

RULES OF THE FEIS

1. Competitors must be pupils of Registered Teachers with An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha who are also registered with AIDA QLD Inc and AIDA Inc for the year 2010.
2. Competitors must be registered with AIDA QLD Inc for 2010 and proof of age must also have been ascertained.
3. **All competitors must be at the venue at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time. This will give them time to enter the sections they choose to compete in.**
4. **All competitors must be in the marshalling area prior to the commencement of their sections otherwise they will miss their dance.**
5. In the case of a tie, there will be no dance off. Competitors in the next position will move back a place.
6. Competitors will be required to dance to music supplied by the Feis committee. If there is a problem with music, either manual or recorded, the dancer will be permitted to re-dance.
7. If a dancer loses a heel or a complete shoe, he/she may stand back allowing the other dancer to continue dancing uninhibited. Such a dancer will then be allowed to re-dance.
8. Should a dancer bump, slip or fall, they may re-dance at the adjudicator's discretion.
9. **If a dancer falls the adjudicator must ring the bell. The dancer will be permitted to re-dance at the adjudicator's discretion.**
10. Lead Round / heavy dancing. In all competitions for Primary, in all heavy dancing ie Jig, the Lead Round must be danced on both right and left foot.
11. In graded sections, competitors are required to perform correct standard of work as set out in the AIDA Inc Competitions Rules and Regulations. Competitors will be disqualified by adjudicators if incorrect standard of work is performed.
12. Make-Up and Fake Tanning will not be permitted for any Dancer in Beginner or Primary for 11 years and under.
13. Dancers competing in Beginner Grade may only wear Team costume, skirt and top with no sleeveless tops permitted. Solo costumes and wigs are not permitted in Beginners. Boys may wear shorts / trousers / kilt and shirt. Dancers competing in the Beginners sections must abide by the Beginner costume rule.
14. The decision of the adjudicator is final. Any protests are to be directed in writing to the Feis organizers, accompanied by a fee of \$100.00, to be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
15. To receive prizes or awards, competitors must be in full dancing costume including shoes.
16. **Any form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means eg mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cinerecorder, commercial film with or without flash enhancement is expressly forbidden in competition unless prior permission has been given by the Feis organizers.**
17. Costume dress necklines must be of collar-bone level or above. This does not preclude the use of alternative fabrics eg lace as an insert
25. Where chiffon or lace material is used as sleeves, the sleeves must start at the shoulder line and end at the cuff.
18. Appropriate underwear must be worn. Where tights are worn they must be of a denier not less than 70.
19. In accordance with our obligations under the Protection policy, dancers are reminded to wear appropriate dress at all times whilst at the Feis (especially in the auditorium area). NB This means for that shorts / skirt must be worn over leotards at all times.
20. The use of artificial arm aids are not permitted
21. Competitors enter at their own risk regarding injury
22. The Crocker School will not accept any liability for injuries sustained. Lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by the dancer, and parent/guardian.
23. **Lodgement of an entry shall be taken to signify that the Teacher, Parent and Pupils concerned accept all these rules in full and agree to strictly abide by them.**
