RULES OF THE COMPETITION

1. This Competition is registered with the Irish Dancing Commission, Dublin and AIDA .
2. Competitors must be pupils of registered AIDA Teachers.
3. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct fee and submitted on the official entry form that has been signed by the teacher. Proof of age must have also been ascertained.
4. No late entries will be accepted and no refunds given.
5. There must be a minimum of three (3) competitors to make up a section. If a competitor is placed in a higher age group than entered eg. 6 years up to 8 years the teacher has the right to scratch the competitor and the entry fee on this occasion will be refunded.
6. In the case of Premiership Sections, after the closing date of entries, competitor's names will be balloted and will appear on the program in the order in which they dance.
7. Competitors must be ready to take their positions on the stage at the appointed times unless under extreme circumstances when a committee decision will finalize the matter.
8. Ceilidh Dance Studio Sub Committee reserves the right to amend the order of dances at any time.
9. In the case of a tie there will be no dance off. Competitors in the next position will move back a place.
10. Competitors will be required to dance to the music as supplied by Ceilidh Dance Studio Sub Committee. Teachers are required to supply own music of Own Choice Set Dances and Figure Dancing.
11. If there is any problem with music, either manual or recorded the dancer will be permitted to re dance.
12. No tape recorder other than the one in use for the dancer on stage may be played whilst a dancer is on the stage.
13. If a show comes off or falls apart during performance the dancer must stop dancing at once and remove the shoe from the stage. They will then be allowed to redance in another pairs of shoes. If the competitor keeps dancing they will not be allowed to re dance.
14. If two dancers bump hard during a performance they may re dance.
15. In Premiership and Graded sections competitors are required to perform correct standard of work as set out in the AIDA Competition and Rules. Adjudicator will disqualify competitors if incorrect standard of work is performed.

16. The decision of the Adjudicator is final. Any protest are to be directed in writing to the organizers of the competition, accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 to be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
17. Competitors enter at their own risk regarding injury.
18. To receive prizes or awards competitors must be in full dancing costume including shoes. Any competitor not in costume will not be allowed to stand on the stage with the other winners.
19. Ceilidh Dance Studio Sub Committee will not enter into any correspondence with parents or non-parents concerning the organization and procedure of competition unless these matters are put in writing and presented at a Sub Committee meeting.
20. No movie equipment or video cameras will be allowed.
21. Failure to comply with any of the foregoing rules shall involve disqualification and the withholding of the prize. The decision of the Sub Committee in any question of dispute shall be final.
22. No prompting by any person will be allowed except in the case of an **INEXPERIENCE BEGINNER**.
23. No makeup to be worn for 12 years & Under as Per Irish Dance Commission rule.
