Syllabus of Competitions:

Age Groups will be decided upon receipt of entries

Novice Reel: First time competitors.

Beginners: Trophy Reel, Slip Jig, Light Jig, Single Jig, Treble Jig

Primary: Trophy Reel, Slip Jig, Treble Jig, Hornpipe, Own Choice Traditional Set

Intermediate: Trophy Reel, Slip Jig, Treble Jig, Hornpipe, Own Choice Traditional Set

Open: Reel or Slip Jig, Treble Jig or Hornpipe, Own Choice Traditional Set

Open Premierships:

Sub-Minor 8 years & under: Reel, Treble Jig and Own Choice Traditional Set

Minor 9 & 10 years: Reel, Hornpipe and Own Choice Jig Time Set

Junior 11 & 12 years: Slip Jig*, Treble Jig and Own Choice Set Dance

Intermediate 13 & 14 years: Reel, Hornpipe and Own Choice Set Dance

Sub-Senior 15 & 16 years: Slip Jig*, Treble Jig and Own Choice Set Dance

Senior 17 years & over: Reel, Hornpipe and Own Choice Set Dance

**Male competitors will dance the Reel where Slip Jig is stipulated.*

Reels in Couples: (maximum 72 bars)

Treble Reel Event: (maximum 48 bars)

Competitors to supply their own music for this event with name, competition age, competitor number and track number clearly marked. Non Traditional dress may be worn.

Rules of the Competition

1. This competition is registered with the Irish Dancing Commission, Dublin, AIDA National Body and AIDA NQ Sub Committee.
2. Competitors must be pupils of Registered Teachers with An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha who are also registered with AIDA NQ Sub Committee, AIDA Qld. Inc and AIDA Inc. for the year 2008.
3. Competitors must be registered with AIDA NQ Sub Committee for 2008 and proof of age must also have been ascertained.
4. Entries must be submitted on the official entry form and fees paid by the due date. **No late entries** will be accepted and no refunds will be given.
5. There must be a minimum of three (3) competitors to make up a section. If a competitor is placed in a higher age group than entered, e.g. 6 years up to 8 years, the teacher has the right to scratch the competitor and the entry fee on this occasion will be refunded.
6. Competitors must be ready to take their positions on the stage at the appointed times unless under extreme circumstances when a committee decision will finalise the matter.
7. Kay Munro School reserves the right to amend the order of dances at any time.
8. In case of a tie there will be no dance off. Competitors in the next position will move back a place.
9. Competitors will be required to dance to the music supplied by the Kay Munro School. Teachers are required to supply their own music for Own Choice Set Dances, Reels in Couples and Treble Reel events.
10. If there is any problem with music either manual or recorded, the dancer will be permitted to re-dance.
11. No tape recorder or CD player other than the one in use for the dancers on stage may be played whilst dancers are on stage.
12. If a dancer loses a heel or a complete shoe, he/she may stand back allowing the other dancer to continue dancing uninhibited. Such a dancer will then be allowed to re-dance in another pair of shoes. If the competitor keeps dancing they will not be allowed to re-dance.
13. Should a dancer bump, slip or fall, they may re-dance at the adjudicator's discretion.
14. No block, en point, stationary or moving will be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the 11 Years & under age groups.
15. If a dancer falls the adjudicator **must** ring the bell. The dancer will be permitted to re-dance at the adjudicator's discretion.
16. Where a dancer fails to complete his/her performance in any given round, that dancer is to be given **zero** marks by each adjudicator for that round.
17. In graded sections, competitors are required to perform correct standard of work as set out in the AIDA Qld. Inc. Competition Rules and Regulations. Competitors will be disqualified by adjudicators if incorrect standard of work is performed.
18. Make-Up & Fake Tanning will not be permitted for any Dancer in Beginner or Primary for 11years and under.

19. Dancers competing in Beginner Grade may only wear a Team Costume, plain basic dress or Skirt and top/leotard with no sleeveless tops permitted. Solo Costumes and wigs are not permitted in Beginners. Boys may wear shorts/trousers/kilt and shirt. Dancers competing in the Beginners Sections must abide by the Beginner Costume Rule.
20. The decision of the adjudicator is final. Any protests are to be directed in writing to the Feis organisers, accompanied by a fee of \$100.00, to be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
21. To receive prizes or awards, competitors must be in full dancing costume including shoes.

22. Any Form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition unless prior permission has been given by the Kay Munro School.
23. Costume dress necklines must be of collar-bone level or above. This does not preclude the use of alternative fabrics **e.g. lace** as an insert.
24. Where chiffon or lace material is used as sleeves, the sleeves must start at the shoulder line and end at the cuff.
25. Appropriate underwear must be worn. Where tights are worn they must be of a denier not less than 70.
26. Appropriate dress should be worn by all Dancers at the Feis at all times.
27. The use of artificial arm aids is not permitted.
28. Competitors enter at their own risk regarding injury.
29. The Kay Munro School will not accept any liability for injuries sustained. Lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by a dancer.
30. The Kay Munro School will not enter into any correspondence with parents or non-parents concerning the organization and procedure of competition unless these matters are put in writing and presented to the principal of The Kay Munro School.
31. Lodgement of an entry shall be taken to signify that the Teacher, Parent and Pupils concerned accept these rules in full and agree to strictly abide by them.
