4. **INTERMEDIATE/OPEN** (11 years & under only)  
Dances: REEL, SLIP JIG, HEAVY SHOE DANCE (JIG/HORNSPIPE),  
OWN CHOICE SET DANCE (TRADITIONAL SET DANCE – 8  
YEARS & UNDER)  
**TROPHY DANCE:** TRADITIONAL SET DANCE
5. **HEARN FEIS IDOL** Solos, Groups and All Levels Welcome  
Age Groups: 10 yrs & under, 13 yrs and under, Open Age

### **COMPETITION RULES**

1. Competitors must be pupils of teachers registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha, Dublin and be registered to compete with an appropriate regional authority for the 2009.
2. Entries must be submitted on the official form, stating the competitor's registration number, accompanied by the correct fee and signed by the registered teacher.
3. No late entries will be accepted and no refunds will be given.
4. A minimum of 3 entries must be received for a section to be run, excluding Novice sections. Entry fees will be refunded in the event that a section is not run due to insufficient numbers.
5. All dancers must report to the marshalling area when called, or risk disqualification.
6. Competitors must be ready to dance on stage **half an hour** before the appointed times, unless under extreme circumstances, such circumstances will be considered by the organising committee. The decision of the organising committee will be final.
7. The committee of the Hearn School of Irish Dancing Feis reserves the right to change the order of dances at any time.
8. Competitors will be required to dance to the music provided by the organising committee. Teachers will be required to supply music for set dances and choreography sections, unless previously arranged with the committee.
9. A dancer will be permitted to redance under the following conditions:
  - a) any problem with the music (either recorded or live)
  - b) loss of a heel or complete shoe provided they stand back and allow the other dancer to continue dancing.
  - c) at the adjudicator's discretion.
10. The Adjudicator's decision is final, and any protests must be submitted in writing to the committee of the Hearn School of Irish Dancing Feis committee and accompanied by a fee of \$25.00. The fee will be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
11. Competitors enter the competition at their own risk regarding injury.
12. To receive prizes and awards competitors must be in full dancing costume including shoes.
13. Any Form of unauthorised photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition unless prior permission has been given by the Feis organisers.
14. Costume and Make-up must comply with the current guidelines adopted by AIDA Inc.
15. No block, en point, stationary or moving, will be allowed to be performed for all ages, up to and including 11 years and under age groups.
16. The use of artificial arm aids is not permitted
17. All other AIDA competition rules will be complied with.
18. Lodgement of an entry form shall be taken to signify that the Teacher, Pupil and Parents concerned accept and agree to strictly abide by all of the above rules.
