RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- 1 Competitors must be pupils of Registered Teachers with An Coimisiun Le Rinci Gaelacha who are also registered with AIDA Qld. Inc and AIDA Inc. for the year 2010.
- 2 Competitors must be registered with AIDA Qld. Inc (North Queensland Sub-Committee) and proof of age must also have been ascertained.
- 3 Entries must be submitted on the official entry form and fees paid by the due date. **No late entries** will be accepted and no refunds will be given.
- 4 There must be a minimum of three (3) competitors to make up an event. Entry fees will be refunded if insufficient numbers are received.
- 5 All competitors must be in the marshalling area prior to the commencement of their sections otherwise they will be disqualified.
- 6 The Association reserves the right to amend the order of dances at any time.
- 7 In the case of a tie, there will be no dance off. Competitors in the next position will move back a place.
- 8 Competitors will be required to dance to music supplied by the Association. Teachers are required to supply their own music for set dances & Reels in Couples/Reels in Threes.
- 9 If there is a problem with music, either manual or recorded, the dancer will be permitted to redance.
- 10 If a dancer loses a heel or a complete shoe, he/she may stand back allowing the other dancer to continue dancing uninhibited. Such a dancer will then be allowed to redance.
- 11 Should a dancer bump, slip or fall, they may redance at the adjudicator's discretion.
- 12 No block, en point, stationary or moving be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the 11 Years & Under age groups.
- 13 If a dancer falls the adjudicator *must* ring the bell. The dancer will be permitted to re-dance at the adjudicator's discretion.
- 14 Where a dancer fails to complete his/her performance in any given round, that dancer is to be given *zero* marks by each adjudicator for that round.
- 15 In graded sections, competitors are required to perform correct standard of work as set out in the AIDA Qld. Inc. Competition Rules and Regulations. Competitors will be disqualified by adjudicators if incorrect standard of work is performed.
- 16 Make-up & Fake Tanning will not be permitted for any Dancer in Beginner or Primary for 11 years and under.
- 17 Dancers competing in Beginner Grade may only wear Team Costume, Skirt and top with no sleeveless tops permitted. Solo Costumes and wigs are not permitted in Beginners. Boys may wear shorts/trousers/kilt and shirt. Dancers competing in the Beginners Sections must abide by the Beginner Costume Rule.
- 18 The decision of the adjudicator is final. Any protests are to be directed in writing to the Feis organizers, accompanied by a fee of \$100.00, to be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
- 19 To receive prizes or awards, competitors must be in full dancing costume including shoes.
- 20 Any Form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means, e.g. film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition unless prior permission has been given by the Feis organizers.
- 21 Costume dress necklines must be of collar-bone level or above. This does not preclude the use of alternative fabrics e.g. lace as an insert.
- 22 Where chiffon or lace material is used as sleeves, the sleeves must start at the shoulder line and end at the cuff.
- 23 Appropriate underwear must be worn. Where tights are worn they must be of a denier not less than 70.
- 24 Appropriate dress should be worn by all Dancers at the Feis at all times.
- 25 The use of artificial arm aids are not permitted.
- 26 Competitors enter at their own risk regarding injury.
- 27 AIDA (Qld) Inc or International Dance Affair organizing committee will not accept any liability for injuries sustained.
- 28 The Association will not enter into any correspondence with parents or non-parents concerning the organization and procedure at a Feis unless these matters are put in writing.
- 29 Lodgement of an entry shall be taken to signify that the Teacher, Parent and Pupils concerned accept these rules in full and agree to strictly abide by them.
- 30 This Competition is registered with the Irish Dancing Commission, Dublin, & AIDA Inc.
