Payment will be made **on the day** with either cash or a cheque made payable to the National Breast Cancer Foundation. 100% of the money received for the 'trophy reel' will be given to Breast Cancer research. Please **do not** include money for this special section when returning your form. The cost per dancer will be \$10.00.

By holding the 'trophy reel' sections and raising much needed funds for research into breast cancer we would like to acknowledge and support women and families who have been affected in any way by this disease.
